Edi-Fi 6.1 Upgrade Notes

Michigan DataHub is migrating to API 6.1 / Data Standard 4

- Upgrade is scheduled for the week of July 1st
- Student information systems need to be upgraded to publish to 6.1
- Any custom SQL scripts will need to be validated and/or revised
- New ODSs will be created during the upgrade.
- Retention of data will be moving to a Current Year + Three historical years. If you need a copy of an older database, please place a ticket with MiServiceDesk.com



Accessing the Cockpit

- Go to <u>www.midatahub.org</u>
- Click "LogIn | MiLaunchPad"
- Type in name of your LEA, PSA or ISD
 - Single Sign On will then be used to log you into MiLaunchPad
 - If your district does not appear, SSO may not have been configured or certificate has expired
- Once on the MiLaunchPad
 - Click MiDataHub Cockpit
 - Other applications you have access to will also appear
 - Additional Sites
 - These are static sites that don't use SSO to log you into the system
 - They will take you directly to the applications website

Review Authorizations

- Add or Remove staff members from Authorization Area
- To add, click the New Authorization Button
 - Input their name and district email address
 - Check the correct cockpit role

DataHub Integrations



Ed-Fi Integrations

Verify each integration is still being used or add new ones as needed


- Inbound Integrations
 - Data that is coming in from other systems, not via an API
 - Most Benchmark data comes in this way
- Outbound Integrations
 - Data is moving from your ODS to another system
 - This is for systems like MiLearn and State Assessment Data
- API Integrations
 - How the majority of data moves in or out of the ODS
 - This is how most SIS systems integrate with the ODS
- To Remove Integration
 - Click name of integration
 - Change "Status" to INACTIVE
- To Add Integration
 - Search for system in <u>Product Catalog</u>



OneRoster 1.1 Scopes

For the 2024-25 school year, SCOPES will be **enforced** based on the official OneRoster 1.1 Specification.

- Vendors must now supply the scope that they are intending to use.
- You will need to update the Year to the current school year





OneRoster 1.1 Scopes

A scope is a set of pre-defined data available to either read, put, or delete.


- **roster-core.readonly** enable access to the getAcademicSession, getClass, getCourse, getEnrollment, getGradingPeriod, getOrg, getSchool, getStudent, getTeacher, getUser, getAllAcademicSessions, getAllClasses, getAllCourses, getAllEnrollments, getAllGradingPeriods, getAllOrgs, getAllSchools, getAllStudents, getAllTeachers and getAllUsers rostering endpoints;
- roster.readonly enable access to ALL of the rostering endpoints EXCEPT getDemographic and getDemographics;
- **roster-demographics.readonly** enable access to the getDemographics and getAllDemographics rostering endpoints;
- resource.readonly enable access to the getResource, getAllResources, ghetResourcesForClass and getResourcesForCourse resources endpoints;
- gradebook.readonly enable access to the getCategory, getAllCategories, getLineItem, getAllLineItems, getResult, getAllResults, getLineItemsForClass, getResultsForClass, getResultsForLineItemForClass and getResultsForStudentForClass gradebook endpoints;
- gradebook.createput enable access to the putCategory, putLineItem and putResult gradebook endpoints;
- **gradebook.delete** enable access to the deleteCategory, deleteLineItem and deleteResult gradebook endpoints.



OneRoster 1.1 Scopes

To select scopes:

- Select the OneRoster API integration
- Select the scope/scopes you are allowing the vendor to use(hold ctrl key for more than 1)
- Make sure the current school year is selected
- Click Submit






EEM Verification Report

State of Michigan Assessment (SOM) Integration

Transfers state assessment data including M-STEP, as well as PSAT and SAT to your MiDataHub environment

Benefits Include:

- Data available for integrating in downstream systems (Munetrix, SIS systems, etc.)
- Districts get data for the students they have rather than the students tested.
- Real time (weekly) reporting on student assessment results.
- Data for previous 3 test cycles is included
- Data available for authorized users to download using the Flex Reports (Custom Exports)

SSO Certs


Ensure your district users are able to access critical systems at the start of school.

MICIP, MiREAD, MiStrategy Bank, Xello and other systems all rely on the federated authentication between their application and the MiDataHub SSO.

Please verify your SSO cert is current by either confirming locally in the saml app provider or by reviewing this list of Expired Certs.



Benchmark Assessment Legislation

- No word yet for 2024-2025, keep an eye out for further communication.
- Updates on this work will be shared in the MDE Spotlight; MiDataHub Newsletter. Steps you can take to ensure you are prepared:
- Verify your benchmark assessment system is configured in the MiDataHub cockpit.
 - **NWEA** 0
 - i-Ready
 - Star
 - DRC 0
- Ensure you are rostering assessment system with the UIC
- After testing has started in your district, please visit the Features Dashboard for Benchmark Assessment to verify the requirements as they were in previous years have been completed.



23G Reporting

- Cohorts need to be published for 2023-2024 before end of school year
 - Each SIS system should have a way to mark which students
 - Expanded learning time (ELT)
 - Intensive individualized support (IIS)
 - Locally Provided Tutoring (LPT) Note: This would encompass homegrown tutoring and non vetted tutoring programs
 - Personalized learning environments (PLE)
 - Career pathways (CP)
 - Work based learning experiences (WBLE)
 - **EWIMS (EWIMS)**
 - High Impact Tutoring (HIT)
- Establish integration with High Impact Tutoring vendors
- Keep watching for information on how to set up the integration to push the data required for reporting
